The International Studies Minor is intended to recognize, for undergraduate students in any major, the completion of an education abroad program, foreign language competency, and related advanced coursework. Ideally, the language, international, and advanced study should be integrated around some thematic or geographical focus.

**Requirements:** 18-30 credits, of which at least 6 credits must be at the 400-level\* - see below.

- I. **12<sup>th</sup>-credit-level proficiency in one foreign language** (demonstrated by course work or examination). A level 003 foreign language course at Penn State will satisfy this requirement.
